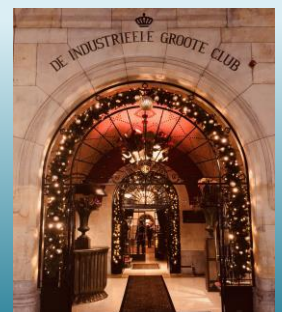


### **NFN autumn meeting – OCTOBER 12<sup>th</sup> Leiden**

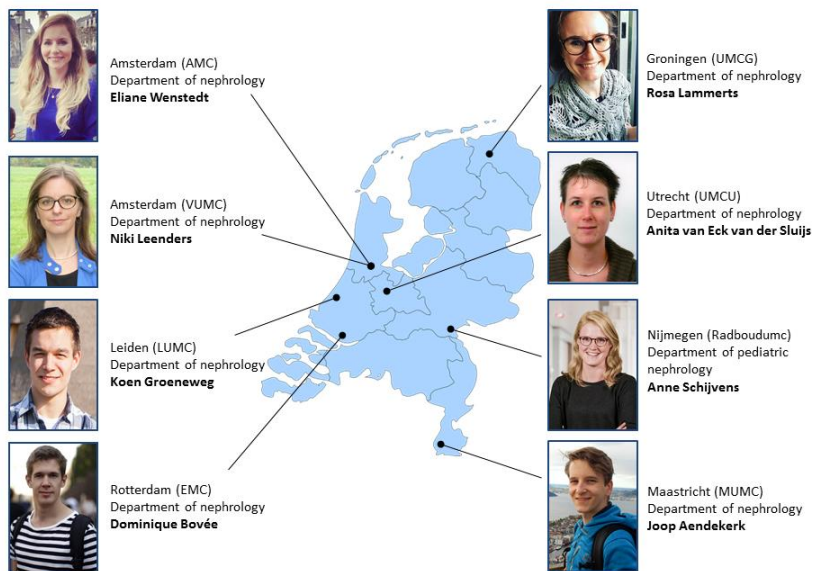
